Safety and Security

DPG DEGREE COLLEGE, affiliated to MDU, Rohtak, prioritizes safety and security for its students and faculty. Here are some of the safety measures and facilities provided by the college:

- 1. Entrance Security: The college has a security guard room at the entrance gate. Visitors are required to register in a visitor's register, and security guards check and register unknown entrants/visitors without ID cards.
- 2. CCTV Surveillance: The campus is equipped with approximately 80 CCTV cameras, ensuring constant monitoring of visitors and activities within the college premises.
- 3. Anti-Ragging Squad: The college has an active anti-ragging squad that works diligently to prevent any untoward incidents, particularly safeguarding first-year students.
- 4. Monitoring of Student Entry and Exit: The college maintains records of students entering and leaving the campus to ensure their safety and security.
- 5. Fire Safety: Fire extinguishers are strategically placed throughout the campus to ensure safety during fire accidents.
- 6. Student Identity Cards: Students are provided with identity cards containing details such as blood group, phone numbers, address, and anti-ragging helpline numbers. These cards facilitate safe entry into various organizations and serve as a resource during crises.
- 7. Self-Defense Training: Interested students are taught self-defense skills like Karate to empower them to safeguard themselves.
- 8. Internal Complaint Committee & Grievance Redressal Cell: The college has established these committees to address the grievances of students. No security breaches or threats have been reported to date.
- 9. Hostel Security: Each hostel has a warden responsible for safeguarding the inmates. Regular security checks and close monitoring are conducted within the hostels.
- 10. Coordination between Faculty and Wardens: Faculty members are expected to coordinate with hostel wardens whenever necessary, especially in cases of irregular behavior or academics.
- 11. Disaster Management: The NSS unit of the college conducts mock drills, workshops, and awareness programs on disaster management for all students.
- 12. Personal Belongings: Students are advised to keep their ATM cards, cash, and laptops safely. Awareness about personal security is emphasized.
- 13. Healthy Relationships and Behavior: Faculty members engage in conversations with students about healthy relationships, behavioral etiquette, communication, and respecting personal boundaries.
- 14. Canteen and College Mess: The college canteen and mess offer food of standard quality, prepared hygienically using a mechanized cooking range.
- 15. Drinking Water: Purified drinking water is made available to all students.

- 16. Sanitary Napkin Vending Machines: Sanitary napkin vending machines are provided for the convenience of students and teachers.
- 17. Code of Conduct: The college provides a code of conduct to the students in their handbooks, ensuring a disciplined environment.
- 18. Two-Wheeler Safety: Students are permitted to use two-wheelers only if they possess a valid license. Wearing helmets while driving is mandatory.
- 19. Pedestrian Safety: Students are encouraged to use pedestrian roads while walking and cross roads only along the zebra lines.
- 20. Gender Sensitivity Programs: The college conducts gender sensitivity programs within and off-campus to raise awareness about gender-related issues.


Overall, DPG DEGREE COLLEGE prioritizes the safety and security of its students and faculty by implementing various measures and facilities

Counselling

DPG DEGREECOLLEGE has strong mentor system for the students to take care of the academic, emotional, social and cognitive development of the student's. Personal Counseling is provided to the students at different levels to address their academic and personal issues.

Personal counseling plays a significant role in the personal and social well-being of thestudents. The distinct feature of College is the mentor system which wasintroduced from the inception of autonomy. This is one of the most effective systems functioning in the institution that bridges the gap between the students and teaching community. Each faculty(tutor) member is assigned a group of students as their wards. The interactions between them help the wards to improve the record of their activities, both in academic & personal fronts. The mentor system in the college has been functioning effectively with the allotment of wards to every faculty. The activities are monitored by the Head of the Department and the Principal. Functioning of Mentor System The mentor system for the wards provides confidentiality space for the students to reveal their problems, academic and personal-physical,mental,financial,situational, social etc. • The Mentor and ward allotment is done according to the staff-student ratio. • The teacher collects personal information from her ward. The teacher meets her wards informally outside class hours. • The rules and regulations, welfare measures and various scholarships available and the ways to go about the mare explained to the wards • The Mentor meets their wards in a time bound manner, analyse

their academic, personal issues and addresses to their problems. •The students address their difficulties to their facultyin-chargeormentorandtherequired solution is sought in the form of counseling, remedial classes, Meditation and Yoga, Financial aid etc., • In specific cases the parents are called and counseling is provided to them also. • The academic performance is monitored and remedial coaching is provided

for the slow learners. • Heads of the Departments are informed and they extend their help and support to students through counseling. • Students have the opportunity to interact with lady doctors for counseling whenever necessary. • In certain cases apart from them enter and the Head of the Department ,The Principal also provides counseling. • A record of the counseling given to the students is maintained in all the departments. • Hostel wardens are trained and advised to take care of the needs of the students so as tokeep them at ease. Wardens update the principal, frequently, regarding the activities of the students in the hostel. • Student union office bearers also play a role in offering counseling to their juniors whenthey has itateto approach he faculty. Faculty Counseling is also provided to the needy faculty and non-teaching faculty to keep them comfortable in the workplace and at home. A common room is provided for faculty and students to relax during the breakhours. This room contains all the facilities for taking rest when the faculty/Students are sick. INTRODUCTION

The introduction of the day care facility scheme by the University Grants Commission (UGC) aims to provide day care services on a payment basis for children between the ages of three months to six years. The objective is to support women and working parents, including male employees, scholars, and students whose spouses are employed elsewhere, in pursuing their academic careers while ensuring their children are well taken care of during the day.

In the case of DPG Degree College, they have also implemented day care facilities for their employees. The day care center should be allocated sufficient indoor space, ideally around 800 to 1200 sq.ft., to accommodate the children. If the number of children increases, the space, staff, and equipment should be correspondingly increased to ensure adequate care.

The day care center should have separate areas designated for activities, rest, and meals. Additionally, it is preferable to have a separate room specifically for infants. The environment should be child-friendly, featuring large colorful displays and activity centers with play materials that children can use independently or engage in guided activities.

Moreover, the day care center should be located in a safe area, away from potential hazards such as traffic, staircases, and elevators. It should also be situated at a reasonable distance from general toilets to ensure hygiene and cleanliness. These considerations contribute to creating a conducive and secure environment for the children in the day care center.

The UGC has introduced a scheme to provide day care facilities on payment basis at college for children of around three months to six years, of age, when their parents (University employees/students) are away from home during day. It includes male employees/scholars/students also whose wives are working elsewhere. In DPG DEGREE COLLEGE also provides facilities for dayqare for their employees.
