3. White wash of Classrooms was made and new printers were purchased for various departments of college

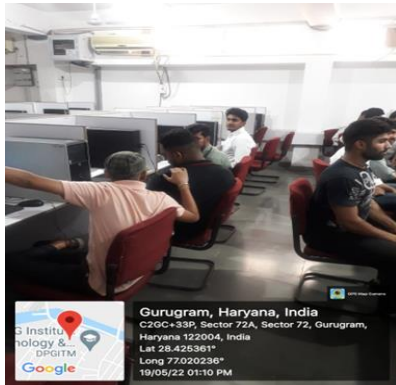

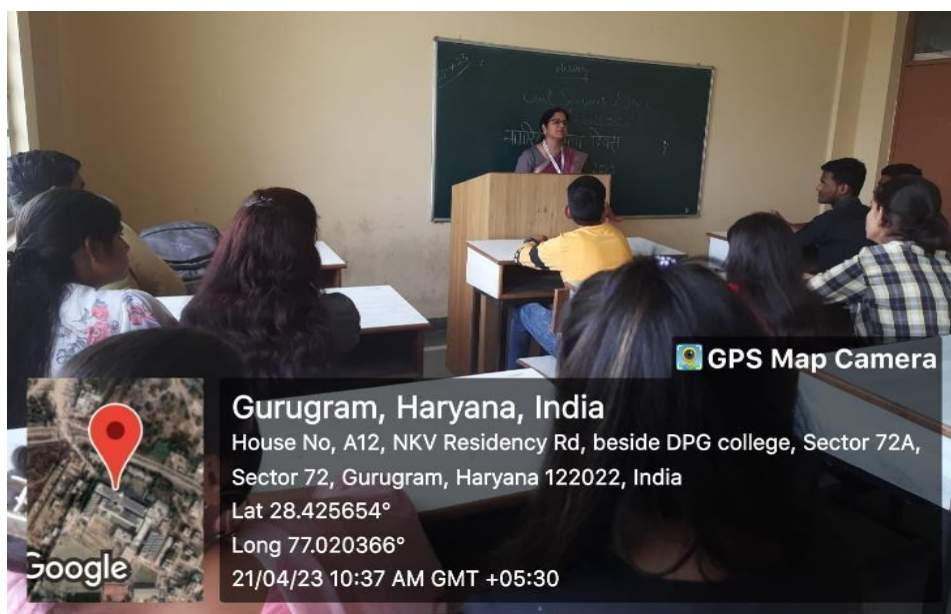

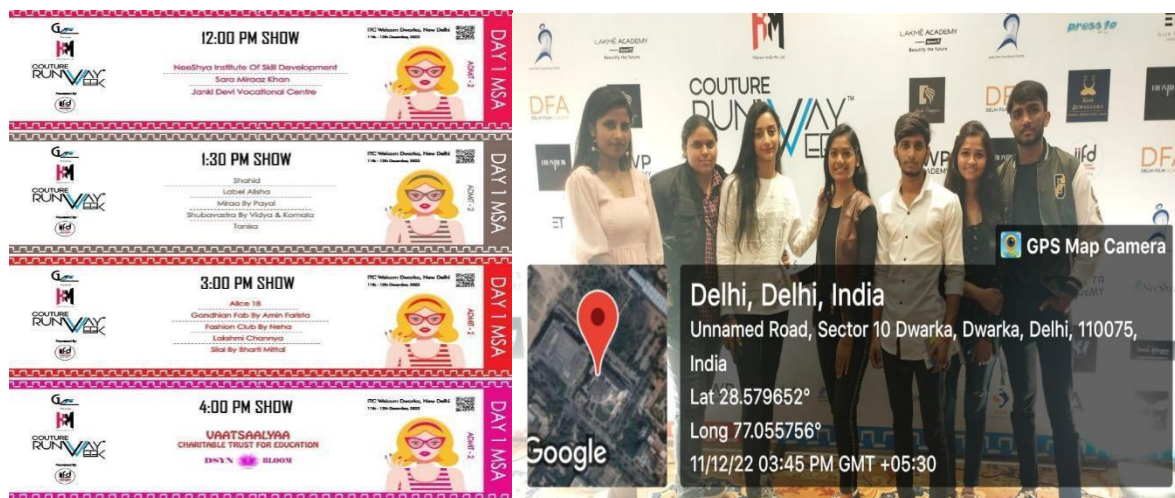


All the winners were awarded with certificates by the judges and honourable Principal sir and Registrar sir.

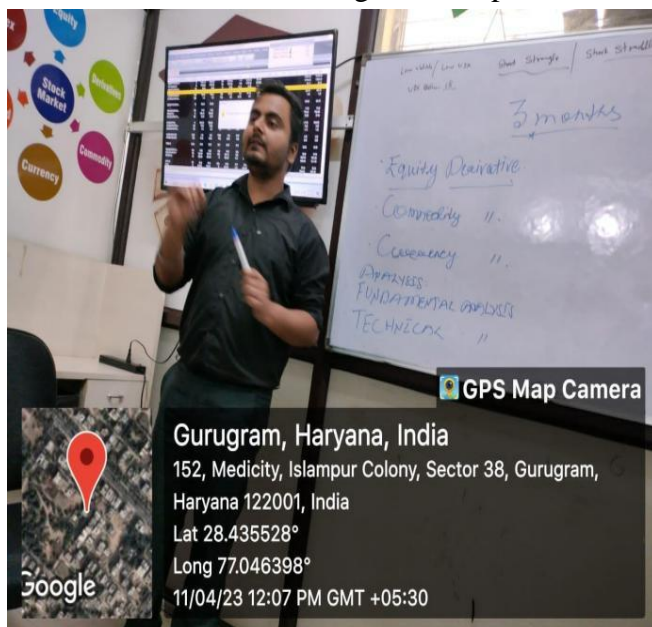


Dr. Dharambir Malik (Dean Academics) also congratulated the Head of Commerce Dept. for organizing the extension lecture which was informative for students and staff members.

WEBINAR ON “INNOVATIONS IN PERSONAL FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT

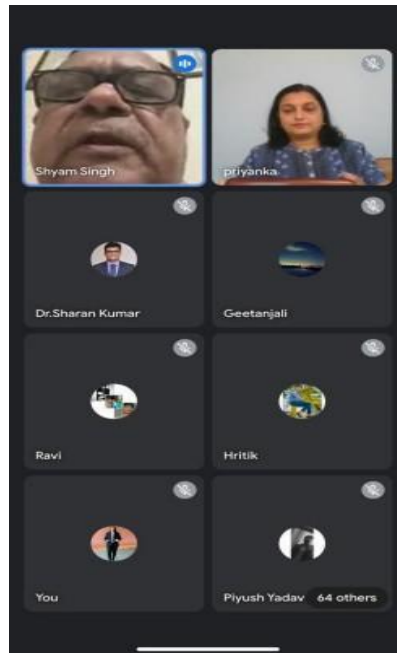

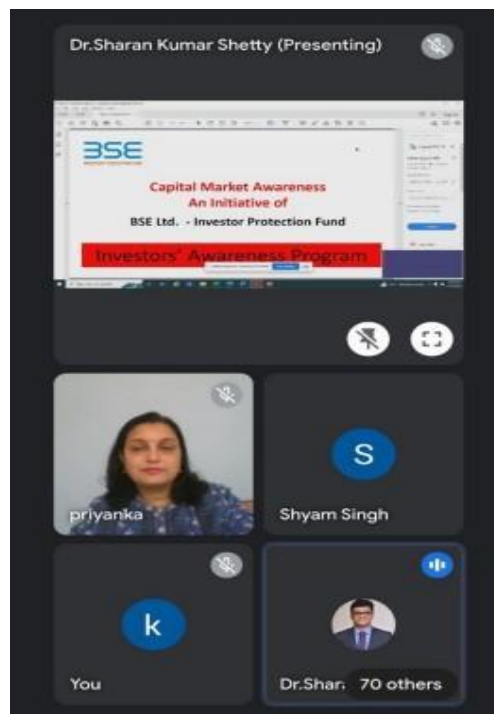

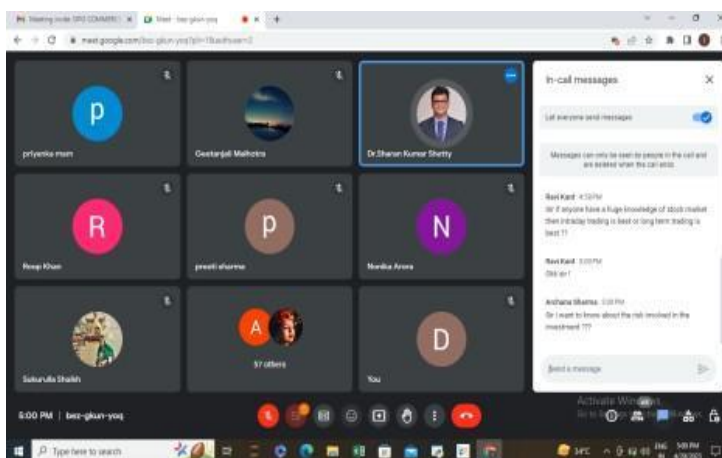

Students were provided with certificates of participation.

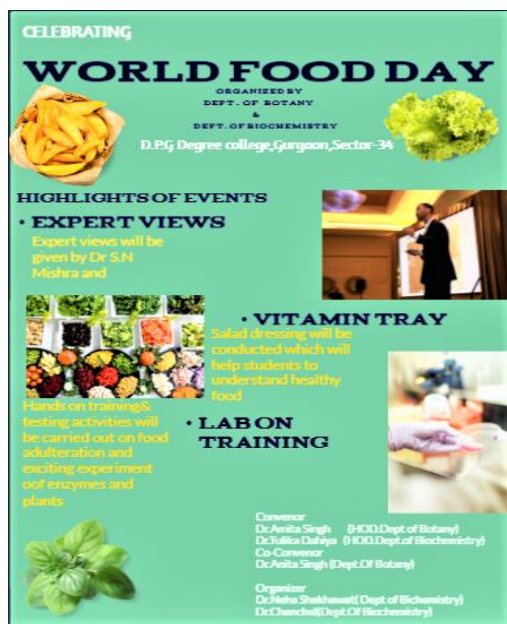

National Conference: Seminar on Entrepreneurship and Business Management organized by Department of Management MDU

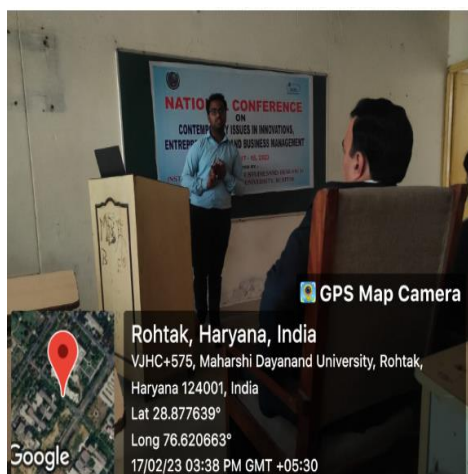
The students and faculty of DPGSTM Participated and presented a paper titled "Pester power in children among varying age groups and gender "at the conference on Contemporary Issues in

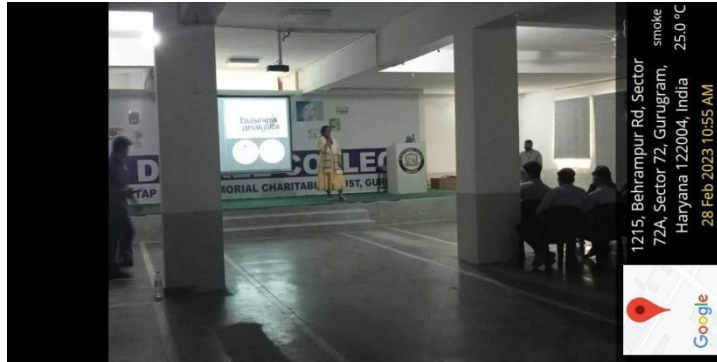

Guest Lecture by Dr. Sonal Dahiya & Dr. Renu Verma on Business Analytics

A guest lecture was organized on 28.02.2023 for BBA and MBA students by Dr. Sonal Dahiya, Associate Professor, IT and Business Analytics & Dr. Renu Verma, Associate Professor, PG Program Chair, JK Business School.

Meaning, scope and the main goals of Business Analytics were discussed in detail. The key points covered are as under:

Business analytics (BA) is a set of disciplines and technologies for solving business problems using data analysis, statistical models and other quantitative methods. It involves an iterative, methodical exploration of an organization's data, with an emphasis on statistical analysis, to drive decision-making.

Data-driven companies treat their data as a business asset and actively look for ways to turn it into a competitive advantage. Success with business analytics depends on data quality, skilled analysts who understand the technologies and the business, and a commitment to using data to gain insights that inform business decisions.

How business analytics works

Before any data analysis takes place, BA starts with several foundational processes:

Determine the business goal of the analysis.

Select an analysis methodology.

Get business data to support the analysis, often from various systems and sources.

Cleanse and integrate data into a single repository, such as a data warehouse or data mart.

Initial analysis is typically performed on a smaller sample data set of data. Analytics tools range from spreadsheets with statistical functions to complex data mining and predictive modeling applications. Patterns and relationships in the raw data are revealed. Then new questions are asked, and the analytic process iterates until the business goal is met.

Deployment of predictive models involves a statistical process known as scoring and uses records typically located in a database. Scores help enterprises make more informed, real-time decisions within applications and business processes.

BA also supports tactical decision-making in response to unforeseen events. Often the decision-making is automated using artificial intelligence to support real-time responses.

ANTI -RAGGING

This Cell is operational, with the Principal serving as the head and faculty members serving as coordinators. The Anti-Ragging Cell is an important part of the Educational Institution's mechanism. According to UGC guidelines under the Act of 1956, which has been modified as UGC regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions, 2009, the establishment of an anti-ragging cell is highly recommended.

As per the order of the Supreme Court of India and subsequent Notification from the University Grants Commission (UGC) ragging constitutes one or more of any intentions by any student or group of students on:

The UGC has issued very strong and detailed regulations for curbing the menace of ragging in Higher Educational Institutions. As per regulations any of the following acts come under the purview of ragging.

- a) Any conduct by any student or student whether by words (spoken or written) or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- b) Indulging in rowdy or disciplined activities by any student or students which cause or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student
- c) Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, torment or embarrassment to adversely affect the psyche of such fresher or any other student
- d) Any act by a senior student that prevents or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- e) Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic task
- f) Assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- g) Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it; sexual abuse, homosexual assaults,
- h) stripping, forcing for obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person.
- i) Any act or abusive spoken words, e-mails, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
- j) Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student.

k) Punishment to those found guilty

The college level punishment in cases of ragging as per UGC directives includes one or more of the following:

1. Suspensions from attending classes and academic privileges.
2. Debarring from appearing any test/ examination or other evaluation process. Withholding of results.
3. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
4. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for specific periods.

Objectives of Anti-Ragging Committee

Anti-Ragging Committee will be the supervisory and advisory committee in preserving a Culture of a Ragging Free Environment on the college Campus. The Anti-Ragging Squad- office bearers will work under the Supervision of Anti Ragging Committee and check places like Hostels, Buses, Canteens, Classrooms, and other places of student congregation. Anti-Ragging Committee will be involved in designing strategies and action plans for curbing the Menace of Ragging in the college by adopting various activities.

The main Objectives of this Committee are as follows:

1. To prevent any physical or mental torture or any disorderly conduct towards any student causing apprehension, dread, humiliation, or agitation in him or her.
2. To maintain a ragging-free campus.
3. To create awareness about ragging & ensure a student-friendly environment at all times.
4. To generate an atmosphere of discipline by sending a clear message that no act of ragging shall be tolerated and any act of ragging shall not go unnoticed and unpunished

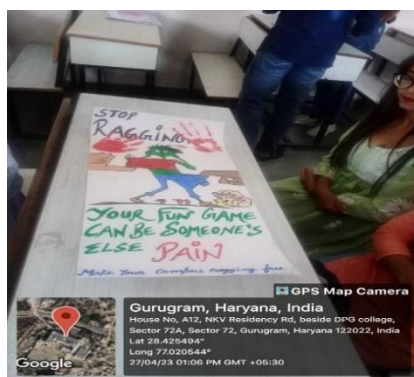

Depending on the nature and severity of the guilt established by the Anti-Ragging cell, A student indulging in ragging can be

1. Expelled from attending classes and academic privileges.
2. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
3. Denied from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
4. Withholding results.
5. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
6. Banned from the hostel

The Anti ragging committee of DPG Degree college Gurugram has organised a slogan writing competition on 'Anti-Ragging Awareness' on 27th April 2023. As ragging has become a menace, a cause of fear and shock for freshers in the country, it led to new laws that curb ragging. This competition aimed at making students aware of the laws of the country with respect to ragging and how it affects the lives of victimised by it. The program commenced with Dr. Nalini Sharma, Convener of Anti Ragging committee, introducing the speaker Dr. Reena HOD Chemistry Department, DPG Degree College Gurugram has experience of over 10 years. Dr. Reena started session by defining ragging as stated by the Honourable Supreme Court of India and Raghavan Committee and then proceeded to open slogan writing competition.

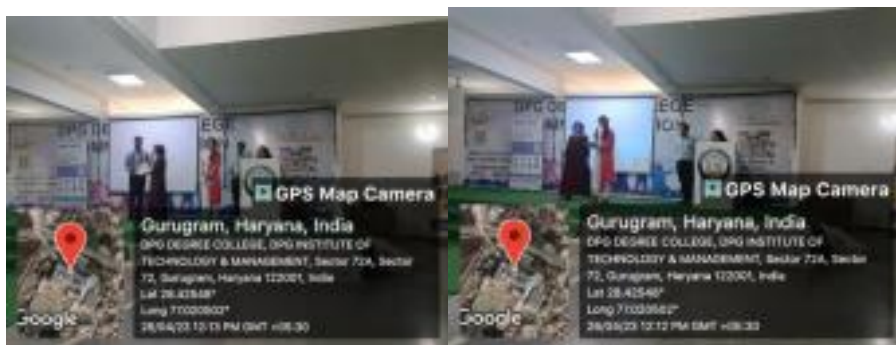
Career Guidance Program by Alumni to final year students of the college:

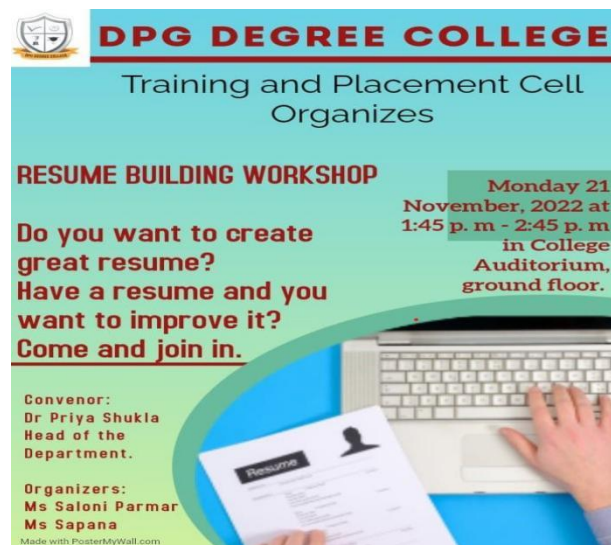
WORKSHOP

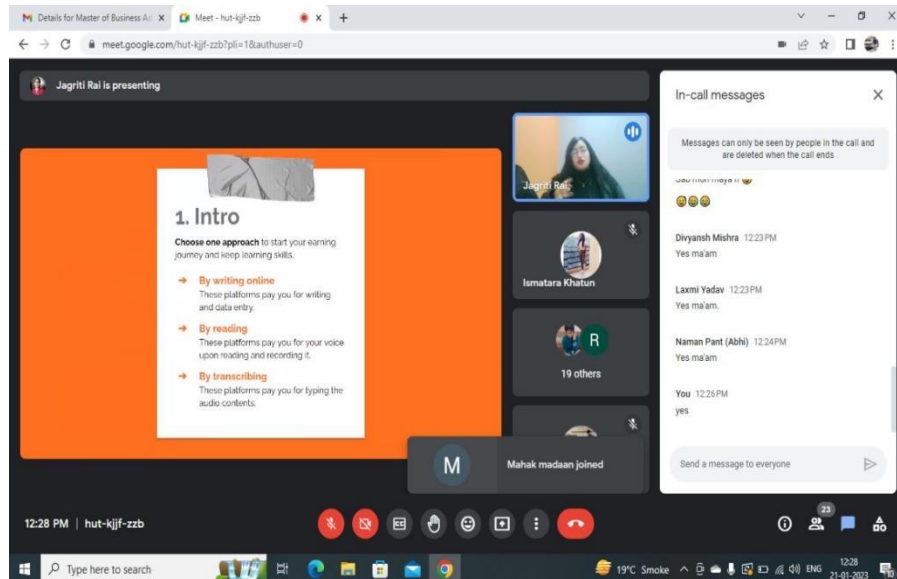

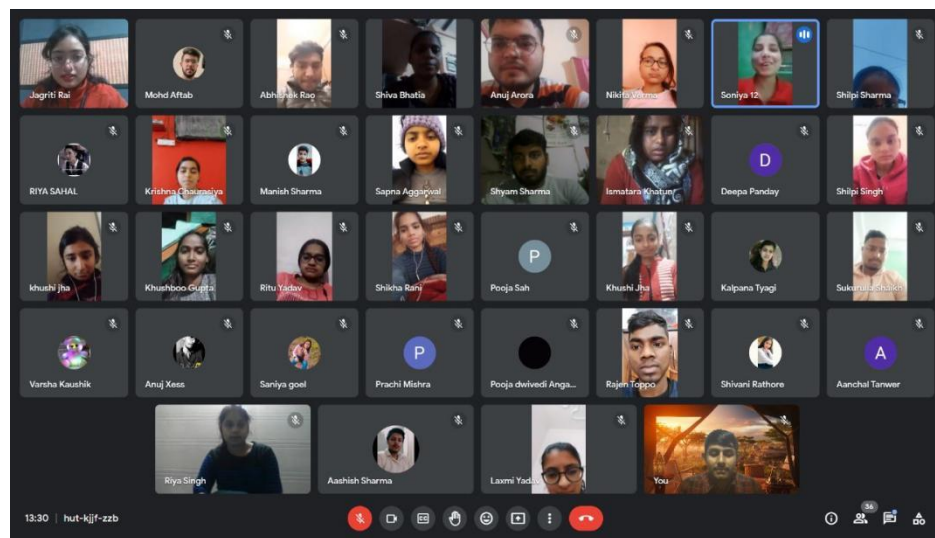
