**Report:**Dr. Shikha Gupta, an associate professor at GGSIPU, SEBI, NSE, BSE, National Centre Financial Education, CDSL, and NISM trainer, led a workshop on November 3, 2023. Dr. Shikha Gupta began her talk by discussing the importance of wealth management and the need for awareness of it. She gave a detailed explanation of how managing our wealth can make or break us. She was incredibly engaging and passionate. She gave an explanation of the De mat account, its differences from bank accounts, and the operation of the securities market. Dr. Shikha Gupta went on to describe the various kinds of markets, public and private companies, both listed and unlisted, securities, and the associated risks and returns. 







