## **INFRASTRUCTURE**

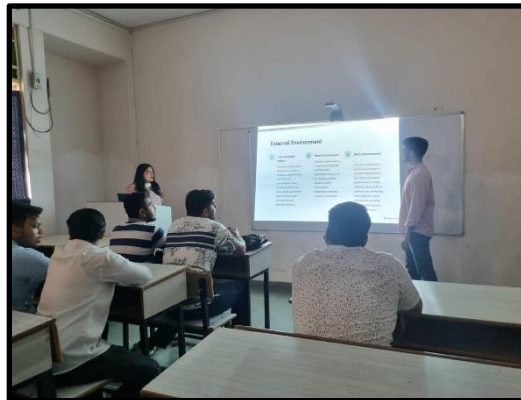

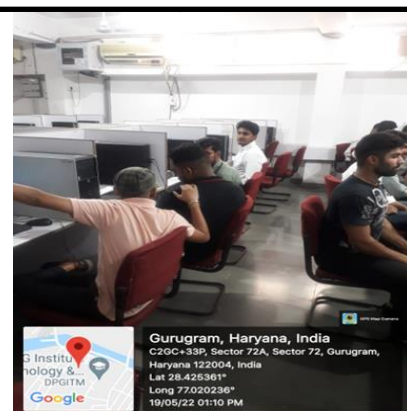
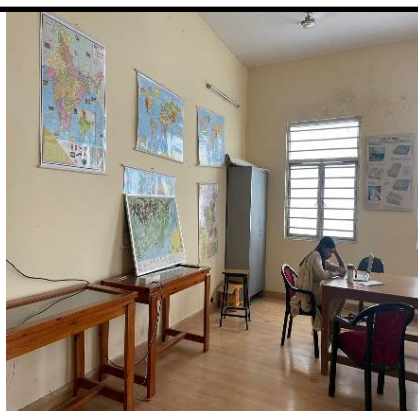

The library is partially automated by customized library software **Education Institute of Information Management (EIIMS)** has been installed. The library is provided with 30 computers with internet and LAN facility, accessible to the students and staff. The library holds a rich collection of printed as well as electronic resources which include books, journals, databases, e-journals, reports, etc. The library with its modern collection of knowledge resources and innovative information services fills an essential role for the academic community in their intellectual pursuits.

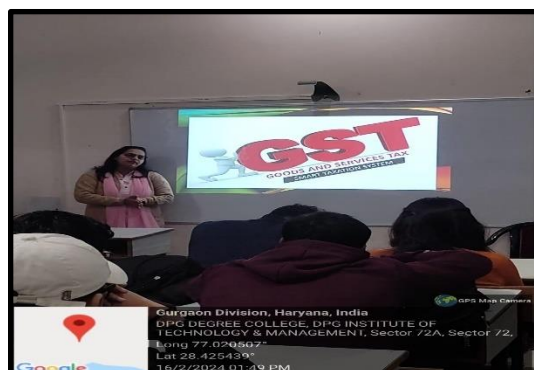

#### **National Wildlife Week 2023**

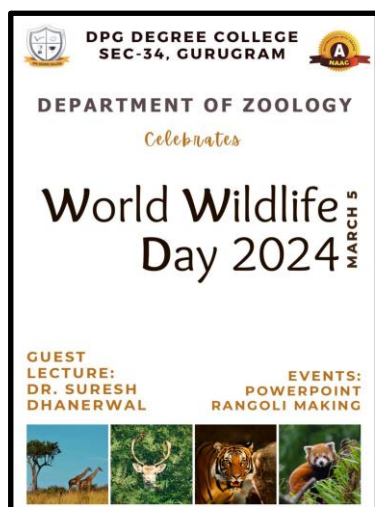

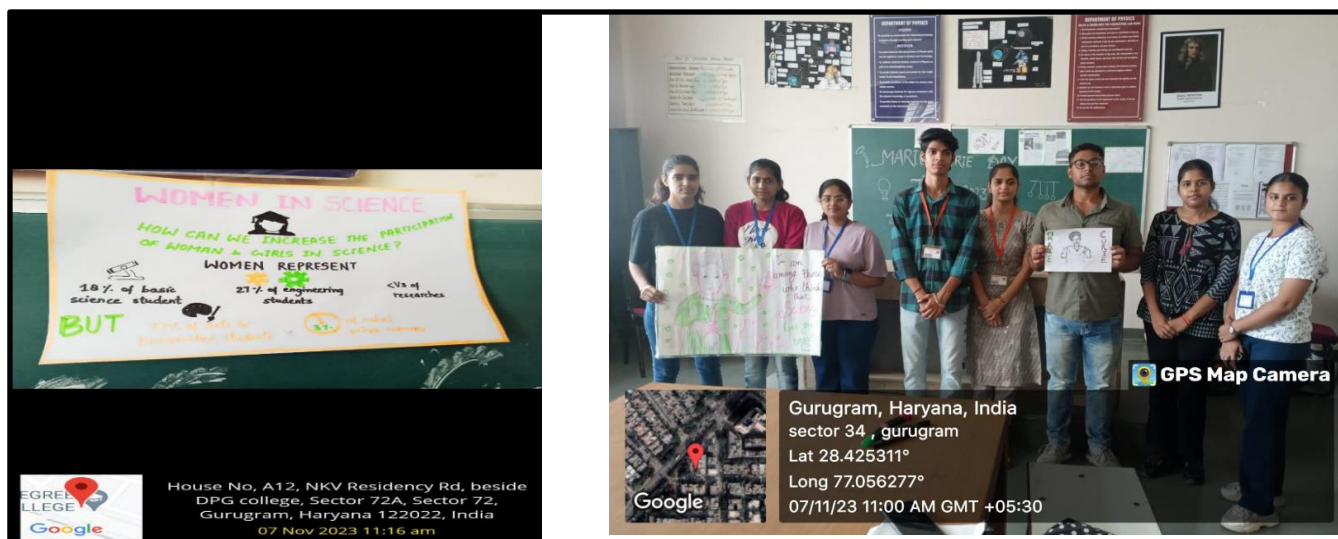
After the workshop students were able to draw the structures in Chem Draw and its use in the interpretation of IR, NMR, and Mass spectrum.

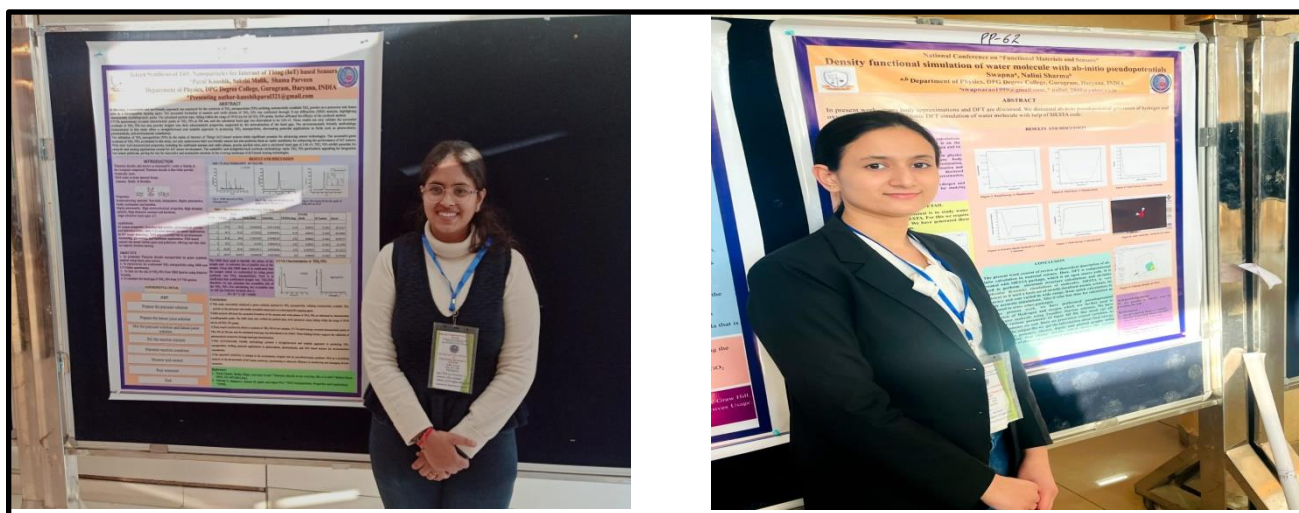
### Marie Curie day

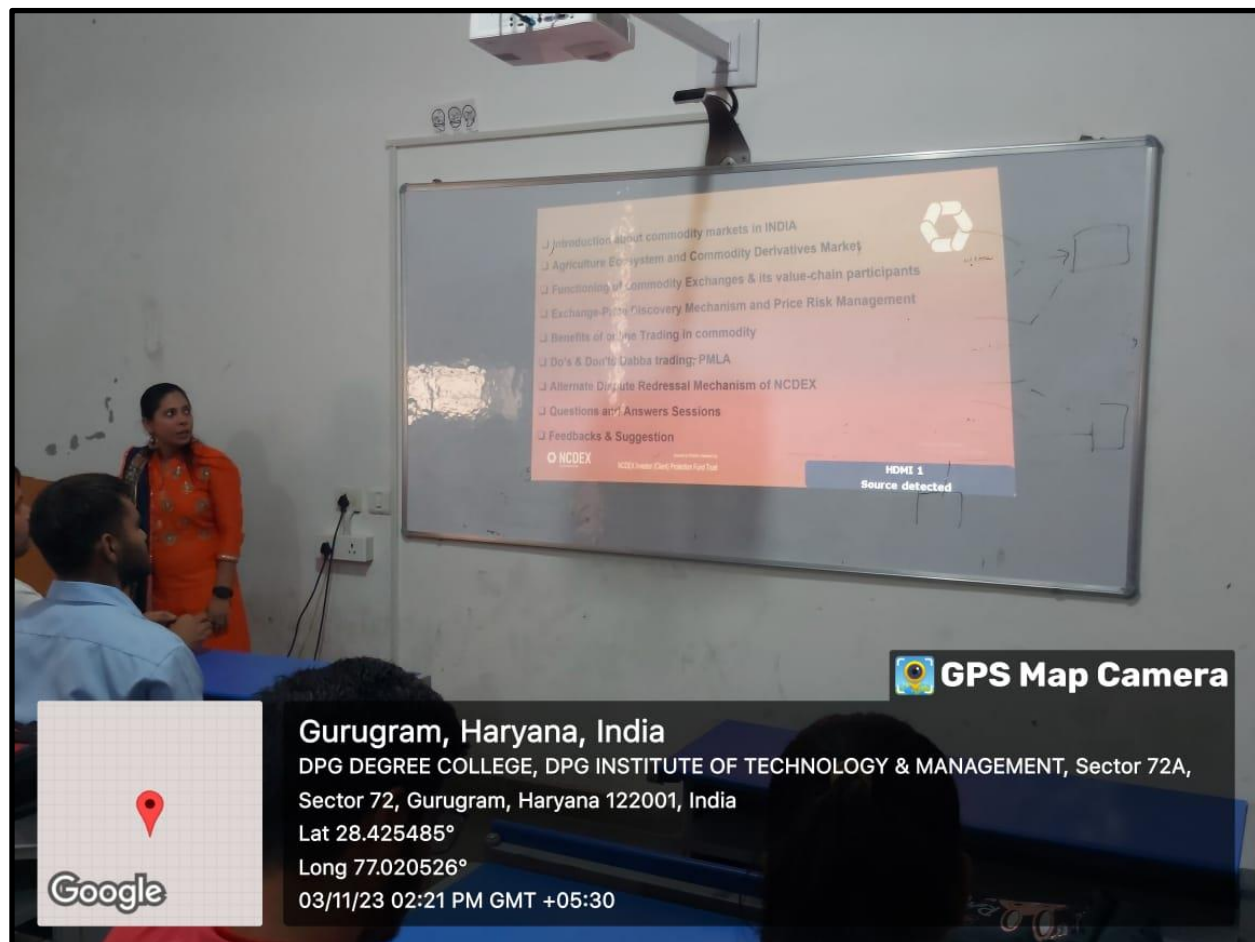

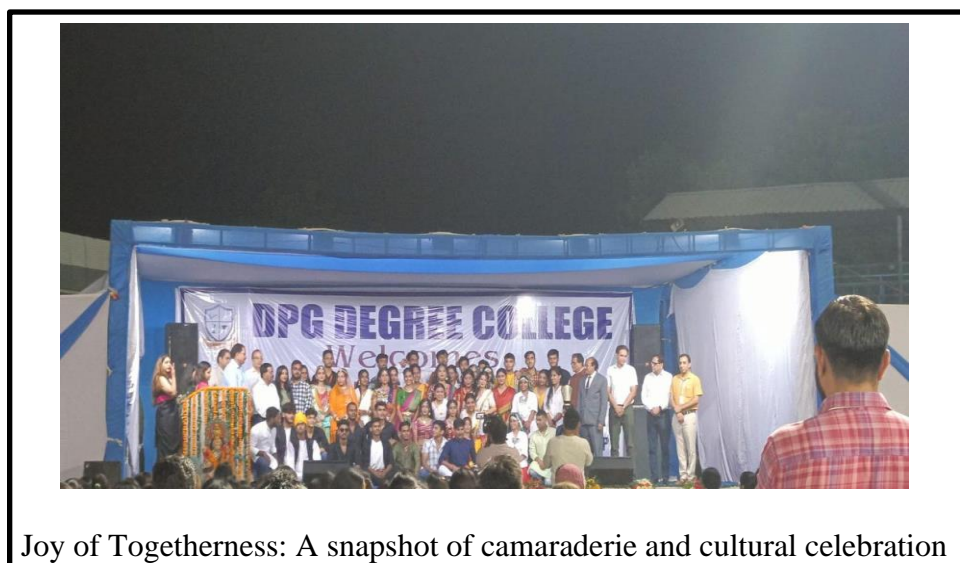
- **Drama and Skits:** Thought-provoking theatrical presentations that addressed social issues and contemporary themes, leaving a lasting impact on the audience.

## **INTER-UNIVERSITY FEST: G.D GOENKA UNIVERSITY**

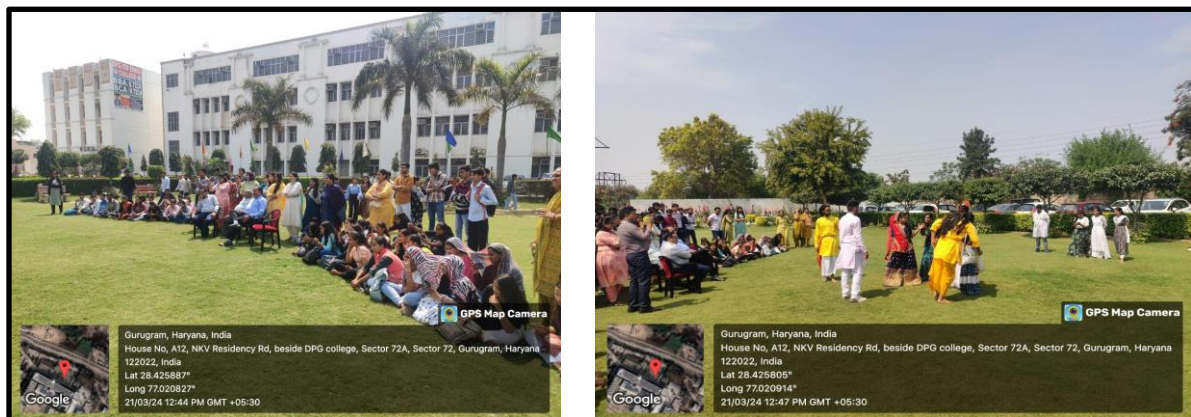

## ENVISION 6.0 - Intercollege At Maitri College (DU)

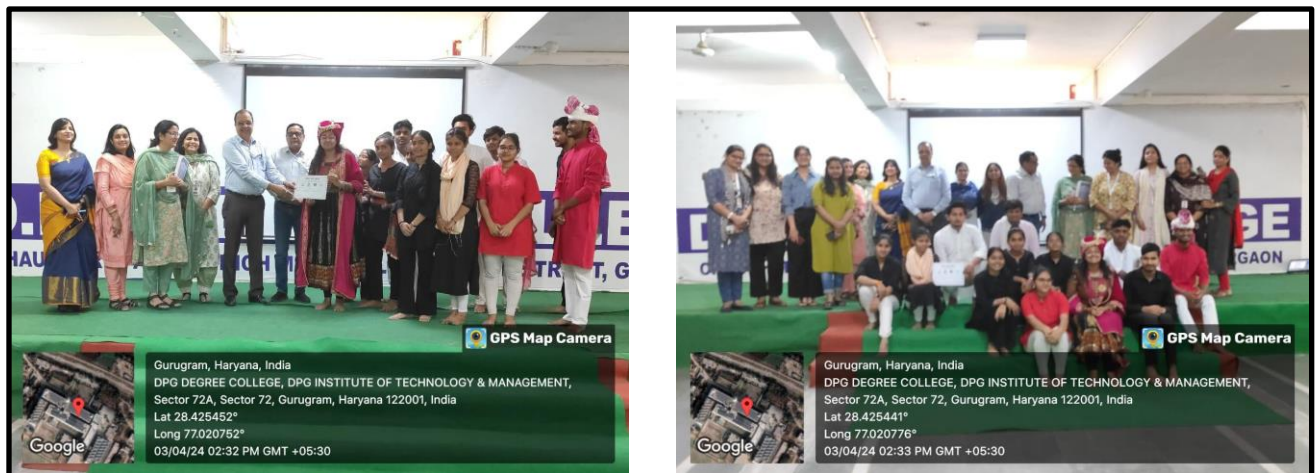

## **ANTI-RAGGING**

As per the order of the Supreme Court of India and subsequent Notification from the University Grants Commission (UGC) ragging constitutes one or more of any intentions by any student or group of students on:

The UGC has issued very strong and detailed regulations for curbing the menace of ragging in Higher Educational Institutions. As per regulations any of the following acts come under the purview of ragging.

- a) Any conduct by any student or student whether by words (spoken or written) or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating, or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- b) Indulging in rowdy or disciplined activities by any student or students which cause or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student
- c) Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, torment, or embarrassment to adversely affect the psyche of such fresher or any other student
- d) Any act by a senior student that prevents or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- e) Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic task
- f) Assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- g) Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it; sexual abuse, homosexual assaults,
- h) stripping, forcing for obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person.
- i) Any act or abusive spoken words, e-mails, or public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
- j) Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student.
- k) Punishment to those found guilty

The college level punishment in cases of ragging as per UGC directives includes one or more of the following:

1. Suspensions from attending classes and academic privileges.
2. Debarring from appearing any test/ examination or other evaluation process. Withholding of results.
3. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
4. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for specific periods.

### **Objectives of Anti-Ragging Committee**

Anti-Ragging Committee will be the supervisory and advisory committee in preserving a Culture of a Ragging Free Environment on the college Campus. The Anti-Ragging Squad- office bearers will work under the Supervision of Anti Ragging Committee and check places like Hostels, Buses, Canteens, Classrooms, and other places of student congregation. Anti-Ragging Committee will be involved in designing strategies and action plans for curbing the Menace of Ragging in the college by adopting various activities.

The main Objectives of this Committee are to prevent any physical or mental torture or any disorderly conduct towards any student causing apprehension, dread, humiliation, or agitation in him or her, to maintain a ragging-free campus and to create awareness about ragging & ensure a student-friendly environment at all times.

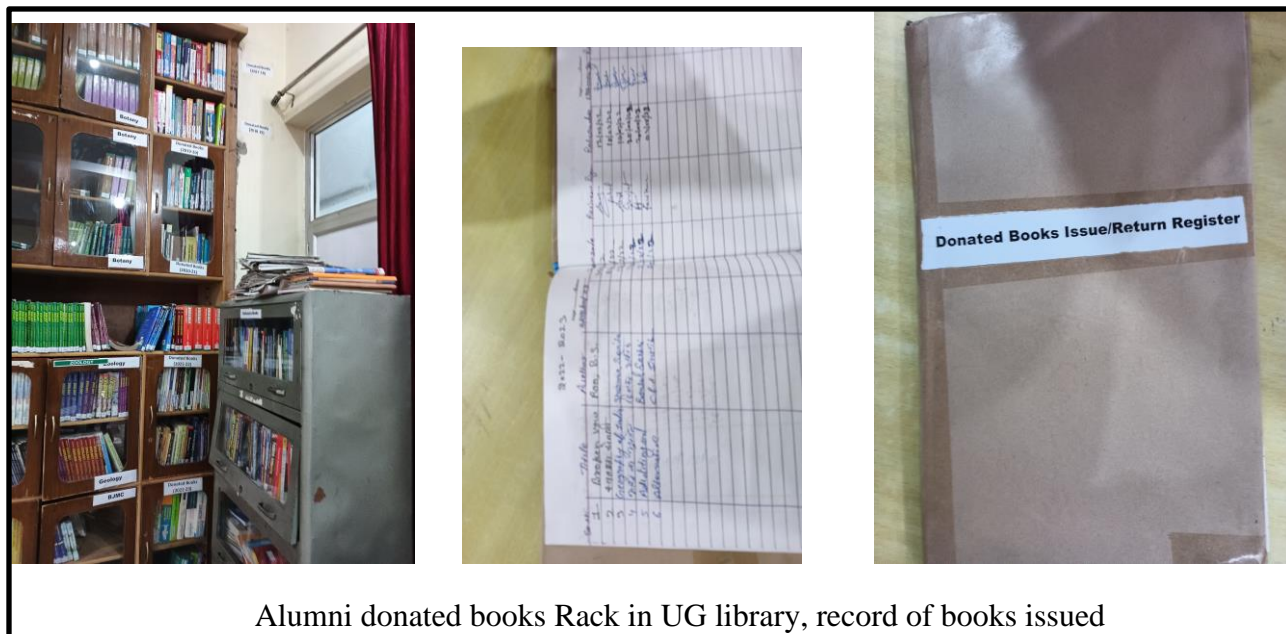

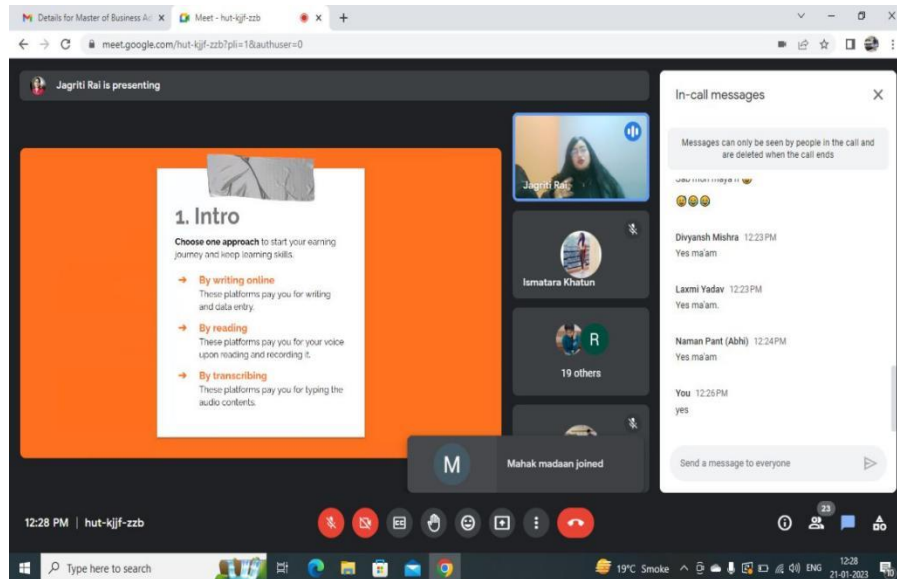
The project aims to provide 6 Months of free training to potential freelancers to improve their skill set and build their personality for good.

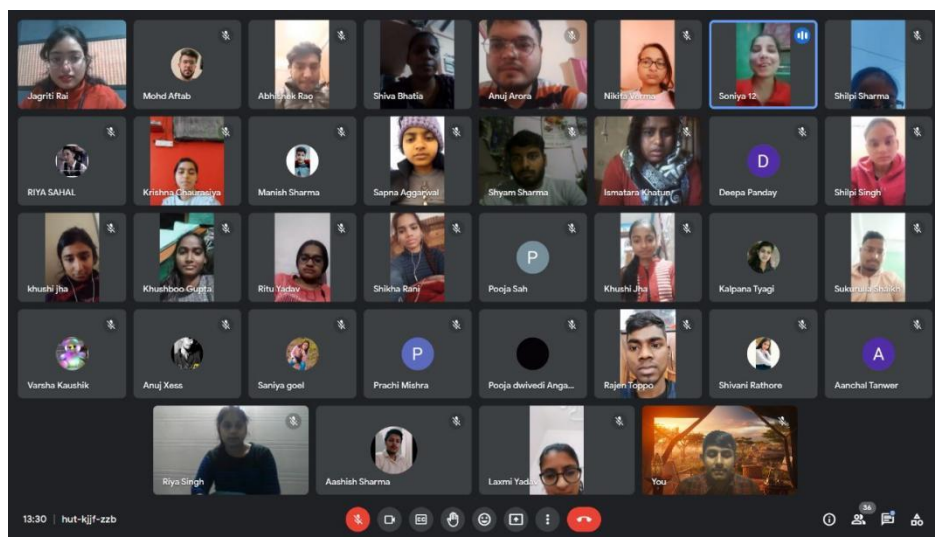
